ackground Research Prabhat The central mission of the Foundation is to create learning opportunities They are also trying: through a new school which will welcome children who cannot cope with Medical Awareness exam-oriented school systems. To achieve this, Prabhat believes it important - Educational Awareness between people for its team to be engaged with a selection of teaching and service activities Education for every children (including special needs) that can help build a competent team of teachers who have the experience Job opportunities(special quota) for special needs. and flexibility to adapt to a variety of learning needs. Awareness about Govt. policies for special needs. First step has been to open a small 'learning through activity' centre, Prabhat for Kids. A Jeevan Taleem programme has been started to serve special children with life skills they need, and to help understand the special education requirements which should be made available through a new school designed to serve their needs. Workshops and camp opportunities for special children have also helped Prabhat to interact with their needs and with their parents. Other partnerships are assisting Prabhat to build its awareness and experience in education. Children at the Prabhat Centres in Maninagar and Satellite learn life skills that can move them toward confident and productive adulthood, at home and in the world.

Students

Students in Prabhat have mental problems, Most of them need special care from their environment. and many of students can live 'normal life'

Teachers

Teachers are trained in special education area. They are specialized to take care of children, Problems are low-loan and too much students.

Family members

Families of Prabhat's children have various range of background. Many of them are comming from rural area of Ahmedabad. They loves their child but not many understanding of the conditions and special teaching method.

Friends & neighborhood

Most of children in Prabhat doesn't have a friends and has no contact with their neighborhoods. It seems because of a lack of understanding or experiences of mental disorder.

Education contents:

Formal and Non Formal Education has basic differences. Formal education is classroom-based, accompanied by trained teachers. Informal education happens outside the classroom, in afterschool programs, community-based organizations. Both formal and informal education settings offer different strengths to educational outreach project, while both schools and after-school programs serve students.

Real learning can happen in a setting where kids feel less intimidated or more comfortable than they do in a formal classroom. 'Prabhat' education system's are also not formal education. Their education system help to come out a special needs children become a simple like a normal. Children. Their teacher never followed them to normal school sylabus, only gives them how to survive on society. Prabhat helps these special children for basic needs not school based education.





She come to Prabhat from last 1.5 years before. Her mom also joined as a teacher of this centre from last six months before. She has Autistic problem and she expression her emotion by gestures only. She moves her head anytime and never speak with anyone sometime except her mother. She likes to nail polish and not like to wear any kinds of jwelerry. She likes to traveling by auto and never doing friendship with anyone. She is very bared in communication problems and socialization also. In play, she likes only swings and loves her grandmother to much.



Hejoined Prabhat from last six months before. He is Autistic, Hyperactive, speaking very limits and if someone reply him by his name, he does not give any reply. He wants to live alone and like to help his mom in kitchen. His behavior is self intimate. He is good in coloring and drawing. He does not like to be a socialize, he does not want to share his thing with another person.



She is almost normal condition, but she is moderate M.R. Her mother realize that Anjali is not normal when she was 6months. She has some friends near her home area. She likes to watch T.V shows, She can read but not write. She oftenly help her mother's house works, and her mother hopes that Anjali become a good house wife.



Joined at Prabhat in 2007
Kangana's condition is severe M.R. and also behavier problem. Activities of daily limit(ADLT) is not easy to her. She has problem with graping, so kangana needs help from other when she has meal. She doesn't like to hear high & heavy sound.

To support of CBR program(community based rehabilitation)


Why:

Prbhat has some CBR(community base rehabilitation) program which includes 4 different slum area like Shah-E-Alaam, Daali Limbda, Nawab kahan ni chali, Chandora Lake etc. Prabhat has a little volunteer who are working in these area and still it is not famous and they have a big loophole in this part. For this program which actually an important part of their mission, needs more money and promotion CBR program also.

How:

(a) Prabhat sometime organizing huge rehabilitation program at that slum area. But it is only based on simple discussion about dieses and about more rehabilitation. For better promotion of this program, some awareness activity through puppet show, which will be designed to teach non-disabled children and even the public about various disabilities, and to show them that being disabled never stopped anyone from being a good classmate, a good friend and shouldn't keep a person from leading a satisfying life. Through this program people can know that even though the persons who are disabled are different, they can lead full and satisfying lives and instead of being ignored, they are potential playmates and even friends.

Feasibility:
All characters for the story are hand puppet where player can change puppet's head and body part. All puppets are making from soft material like stuffing toys. Puppets are produce through a workshop, where giving training to teacher of Prabhat for puppet making and teacher will start a mission for children for puppet making. It will help children also in future when they will go back to his/her society after education, start also individual business of puppet making and also help to his/her family for earning money.

Uniqueness:

Awareness program through puppets are not very existing. People also like to see this kind of show where they get some fun and easily understand also. These kinds of puppets(part assemble) are not common and the case of rehabilitation area, it is quite new.

Production:

All puppets are made from scrape cloth and wastage cotton(for stuffing), collecting material from local tailors by paying hundred rupees and get a lots of cloth for puppets.



(b) Another way, string puppet(kath-putli)also help for supporting Prabhat's CBR program. These string puppets will make by local puppet makers(kath-putliwala).

The production cost of string puppets are to low and this medium is to famous for public also and a big communication system between puppets and public. This kind of puppets has not need to much material also. So, this string puppets are also one of the way of express Prabhat's story on CBR program.

Materials: Soft wood, westage cotton, fabric, threads for dancing puppets by hand.





Opportunity:2

To design Toys for Prabhat promoting

Why:

To promoting Prabhat with branding approach which will help to market of some toy ranges which is given them an unique approach for selling and marketing it.

How:




Toys for promoting Prabhat

Feasibility:

All product ranges are made from scrape wood and manufacturing by local wooden vendors which not need huge amount of money, because the wooden scrape are collected from local furniture industry as a wastage and for buying scrape, they have used only a little amount of money which they get back after their product selling, and one person from Prabhat who will involve for taking care of making product. Over all concept is based on "Earning money for Prabhat without investing large amount of money."











Opportunity:4

Role play

Why:

(a) Role play will encourage children for imagination, imitations, and performance abilities and also for basic skill improvement which much needs for Prabhat.



How:


(a) Want to make an interactive picture book, which will develop the children's imagination, imitations and basic skill also.

Through this story book he/she would be one of the parts of the story and role himself like the depiction of the stories and it also gives them fun and develop these children's imagination capacity. As a character of story, he/she would be develop finger movements ability. In first page story of three cats who are drinking milk from the pot. Through this image children also act like cat. Same next page has another story(e.g. two dancer is dancing) and also react like the story.

Feasibility:

This interactive story book help to develop children visual communication skill along with basic finger and hand movement skill when they react like the story image.

Riverside school student also come to Prabhat, they also might be the part of this activity. Even in home also special children can play with his/her sibling also. The illustrations of that book will also make by student. The character for roleplaying will make from wastage cloth which will be collects from tailor and stitching. These character of the stories will be put along with the book.





Want to develop a range of product which will help to encourage for role play act.

How:

Riverside school children comes to Prabhat for play with children. Prabhat has different kinds of children which has different kinds of ability. Riverfront school children will play with Prabhat children.eg.lf one children does not able to do anything by left hand, then Riverfront school student also wearing this product on his/her left hand which will pack his/her hand and doing some act, which that disable children tell him.

These range of product will make from scrape cloth and it will encourage for friendship and also for acting ability which will help to improve Prabhat children's basic skill like hand movement, body movement and through these activity.



How:


(c)These role play corner which will contain some caps or turbans, it will also be involved in development for children's motor skills (how to ware on head by hand) and also develop about an idea on different peoples headgear which also improve their vision about different places and people and also give them a funny and competitive atmosphere.

Material: For this concept, needs only some cloth turban.

How:

Want to start a workshop for children, where children will doing some clay work which is plasticine and they make some form which depict some image like aero plane, ship, bird etc/will tell them whatever you like to make). They have also their own imaginary world, which they make in clay. This activity will help their creative activity and also help basic hand skill development.

After their works, it converted to mold and pouring it wax by children where Prabhat teacher help them as a course curriculum.

Feasibility:
For starting this program, Prabhat needs a little money and they can sell it through Pehchaan who already involve to sell Prabhat existing craft product and they can sell these candle as a product which make by some extraordinary people with extraordinary work. Pehchaan also has their own website, from where they can advertize these products.

Through this mission, people also start to know about Prabhat.

FINAL SYSTEM WORKING PROTOTYPE:

After all of my oppertunities, I given the final proposal of puppets (katth-puttli which are belongs from local puppet art made by puppeteers. The main interesting part of these puppet's are, they are totally traditional which are existing in Ahmedabad and very popular among the common people. This final opportunity has a lots of potentiality and also strongly feasible for "COMMUNITY BASED REHABILITY" program. Puppets are known as best communication medium of general public from old ages.

FINAL STORY:

There are a poor family. This family has four members KARIM who is a 15 years boy, he has not right leg. But he lives very joyfully. His elder brother's name is MUSTAAK..he is a23 years school boy, but he does not do anything for their family.SALMAANBHAI is KARIM's father and SAYERA is his mother's name. They are poor family, but although they are poor, they lives very polite and gently in DAALI LIMBDA area of Ahmedabad.KARIM's mother father loves his elder brother MUSTAAK very much then him. But KARIM lives very enjoy fully. One day, some Govt.Officer came to their village to find a good boy who is physically disable but who have potential for doing everything with joyfully.Govt people has an offers to disable people to sent them for special Olympics.

KARIM is selected for special Olympics by govt officer and KARIM gets medal in special Olympics. These day govt has offers to their family,5000 RS/mnth as a honors for winners the game. Thus,KARIM bring a great name for his family and also for his area, his state and country also. Govt offers him a USA trip with his family.

Actualy, this story is inspired from a real story of a disable children of "PRABHAT" who wins the award in special olympics. They are not "DISSABLE" but can say specially able. This stories characters are developed from the local people of the slum area where "PRABHAT" is still running CBR program.

PRODUCTION COST OF THE PUPPETS:

The manufacturing cost of the puppets are not very much. Each character's manufacturing cost is only 85 RS, which are the local puppeteer's selling price.

PROCESS OF MAKING:

The same process of manufacturing of local puppets. Material are mainly softwood like GULMOHAR, stuffing cotton(all are wastage), normal enamel based paint and fabric.

THE PUPPET SHOW:

Puppets will show by puppeteers group whose coast are not very much.1400 RS for one show.
